Josh-Jitsu Mathematics Terms and Conditions and Waiver

Josh-Jitsu Mathematics, or JJM as it may also be referred to for brevity, is a math instructional service. It is not a school and as such its courses do not offer credits. It is a purely educational resource. Josh-Jitsu Mathematics is a self-motivated program. This means that those who participate are responsible for their own learning. Homework, Quizzes, Tests, etc. may or may not be assigned and participants are expected to take it upon themselves to review lessons taught by JJM instructors, take notes, research the topic in external resources besides JJM, and practice the given concepts both during and after JJM sessions in order to achieve mastery. The JJM instructor is there to teach the lesson in accordance to the JJM curriculum and answer questions regarding the topic of the day. The responsibility of mastering the material is placed upon the student.

Sessions will not be offered on Holidays. If sessions will not be offered on a certain day or time, this will be made known prior to cancellation either on the website or through email or both.

Zoom Microphone Policy

Josh-Jitsu Mathematics is an online instructional service that meets on Zoom. Microphones are to be muted during sessions unless otherwise called upon to speak. When an individual is unmuted, they must ensure that they are adhering to an appropriate learning environment (See **Appropriate Learning Environment**) Those in violation of this policy may be removed from the session. If they are, they will NOT permitted to return to that session. They may attend the next session provided they adhere to this guideline. Whether or not an individual is in an appropriate learning environment is at the discretion of the JJM instructor and they reserve the right to remove anyone from the Zoom session if they suspect this guideline is not being followed. If you are unsure whether you are following this guideline, ask the instructor prior to the session.

Zoom Camera Policy

ALL Participants are to include their First and Last name on their Zoom ID. They may choose to use their First Name and Last Initial if they choose. This is to ensure that the proper participants are participating at the correct time. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the participant being removed from the session.

You may choose to have your camera on or off. If you choose to have your camera on, ANY participants or individuals not participating in the session but can be seen through the camera who are either naked or have undergarments showing will be removed from the session and NOT permitted to return to that session. They may attend the next class session provided they adhere to this guideline. The JJM instructor reserves the right to remove anyone from the Zoom session if they suspect this guideline is not being followed. If you are unsure whether or not you are following this guideline, ask the instructor prior to the session.

Appropriate Learning Environment

Participants are to ensure that their learning environment (The room or space which is viewable and hearable by the camera and mic) must also not have any inappropriate items or inappropriate behaviors. This includes but is not limited to items such as undergarments, drugs, pornography, or behaviors of a sexual, violent, or bullying nature. Those in violation of this policy will be removed from the session and NOT permitted to return to that session. They may attend the next class session provided they adhere to this guideline. Whether or not an individual is in an appropriate learning environment is at the discretion of the JJM instructor and they reserve the right to remove anyone from the Zoom session if they suspect this guideline is not being followed. If you are unsure if you are following this guideline, ask the instructor prior to the session.

Recording Policy

Participants are NOT permitted to record except for the JJM instructor. However, Josh-Jitsu Mathematics reserves the right to record or not record any session and reserves all rights to session recordings. Josh-Jitsu Mathematics also reserves the right to post or not post recorded session videos on joshjitsumath.com or YouTube for promotion/advertising purposes or so participants have access to sessions.

Josh-Jitsu Instructor Policy

In order to ensure that all participants are able to learn JJM material in an appropriate learning environment, JJM instructors reserve the right to remove any person for any reason at any time from a JJM session. This includes but is not limited to reasons for removing individuals from a session that are included within this Terms and Conditions. JJM instructors are not required to re-admit removed participants back to a session or admit them to future sessions. In such events that a participant must be removed from the session, these cases will be handled on a case by case basis. If JJM determines that they can no longer provide JJM services to an individual, that individual will be removed from the JJM program, cease being charged for JJM services, and will NOT be refunded any payments prior to the incident.

Attendance Policy

Students may choose to attend or not attend as many lessons as they choose. Failure to attend a session will still be charged and no refund will be issued. If at least 24 hours notice is given prior to the scheduled session time that the attendee will not be able to make it for any reason, then the session will be cancelled and it will not be charged.

Late Policy

If a student intends to attend class, they are required to join the zoom session 5 minutes prior to class starting to ensure that we can start the session on time. Students will not be admitted once the class begins if other students are already in attendance. In the event that no one is in attendance when the class begins, the instructor will wait 15 minutes past the scheduled session time and will allow individuals to join during this time. If no one arrives, then that session will be canceled, the session will be charged, and no refund will be issued.

Leaving a session willingly or due to internet issues

Participants should ensure that they have a reliable internet connection and are able to participate in the session for the duration of the entire session. Participants who join the session on time but leave willingly or due to internet issues may rejoin the session. If the participant does not rejoin within 15 minutes without communication to the instructor, the instructor may leave the session and cancel the remaining session time. The session will still be charged and no refund will be issued. If the participant communicates that they are trying to rejoin the session within 15 minutes of leaving the session for any reason, the instructor must wait in the session for up to the session's duration time. If after the session time ends the participant has still not rejoined the session with or without communication to the instructor, the instructor may leave. The session will still be charged and no refund will be issued.

Payment Policy and cancelling your package early

Those who opt to participate in any JJM service can pay for services rendered using 1 or more of the following: Zelle, cash, check, a pay link through which they can pay with a credit card, or PayPal. Members will receive the zoom link to join the JJM sessions via the email they provide. Members are not required to attend classes and failure to participate in JJM sessions will not result in a refund. Members may cancel their package at any time, but doing so will not result in a refund for any previously paid months, or sessions, including the month members cancel their membership.

Private Tutoring Sessions Policy

Private sessions may be scheduled by appointment. The session will be either online through zoom, or in-person at an agreed upon public location such as a library or coffee establishment. Participants are required to bring the material they wish to work on. This includes any JJM curriculum material or other math curriculum material that is agreed upon to work on prior to the session. Participants are required to submit what they wish to work on prior to the session. Payment is required prior to the session.

If a customer pays for a session, but a time is not agreed upon or the subject is not one that JJM can facilitate, the customer will be refunded (This will be discussed prior to paying for a session to avoid this situation). If the JJM instructor fails to show up for the session, the customer may choose to either reschedule at no additional cost or receive a refund. If a session is scheduled, but the customer does not attend, the session will still be charged and no refund will be given. In such a case, the customer may request to reschedule, but will have to pay for another session. The JJM instructor must wait for the customer to arrive for 15 minutes after the session was scheduled to begin. If the customer fails to

arrive to the session, the instructor may leave after 15 minutes in accordance to the 'Late Policy' of this Terms and Conditions and Waiver document. In such a case, the session will still be charged and no refund will be issued.

If an in-person session is requested, the customer will have to pay a travel fee based on distance and time the instructor must travel. This will be discussed prior to the session.
